<p><b>Job Description</b></p>	<p>Assistant Professor – Department History, International relations and civilizations.</p> <p>Teach students on undergraduates and postgraduate Academic Programs at PSUAD, ensuring appropriate support is provided and high-performance levels achieved. In addition, conduct research in a personal area of interest related to the faculty in order to raise the profile of PSUAD and contribute to the knowledge development of the local and international community.</p> <p>1) Deliver teaching courses (234 hours/academic year) to facilitate student learning outcomes and aim for teaching excellence for the department, including but not limited to preparing teaching material in advance; communicating subject matter in a way students can understand; observing student progress and learning styles; reacting appropriately to student’s needs; responding, where appropriate, to student questions outside class times; preparing for contingencies in course delivery etc.</p> <p>The teacher will give 6 lectures per year, in Licence 1 and 2, in the following fields, for example : contemporary history (3), modern history (2), general historical culture (1) and tutorat.
